The second-to-last day of the Nationals has brought major leaderboard shake-ups and a last-minute surge of entries, thanks to improved weather. Across the country, most regions have been affected by rough conditions, and this year's results clearly show who adapted their fishing techniques and target species to make the most of it.

If you focused on just one species, you may now be feeling the consequences, while those who adjusted their approach are climbing the leaderboard.

A massive highlight today – our immediate past president, Ian Steele, has successfully tagged a striped marlin with a pop-off satellite tag, fishing with the New Plymouth Sportfishing and Underwater Club. These tags are crucial for tracking marlin movements, depth preferences, and speeds, providing valuable data for the future.
